
Eligibility Quick Reference Guide

Master Teacher Inititative

- A teacher's Master Teacher Initiative (MTI) eligibility category is determined by the teacher's role and course schedule during the data collection year.
- Teachers will only have <u>one</u> category to determine eligibility for MTI.
- Teachers with more than one eligibility category based on the courses they are assigned will default to the applicable category based on the order of priority:
 - 1. STAAR/EOC
 - 2. APA/MAP/Circle
 - 3. Student Learning Objective (SLO)







General education, Bilingual, and Special Education teachers who teach at least one of the following subjects-Algebra II, Geometry, Precalculus, 6th grade Social Studies, 7th grade Social Studies, Economics, Personal Financial Literacy, US Government, World Geography, World History, Chemistry, Environmental System, Physics, 6th grade Science, 7th grade Science, English III, and English IV (Note: APAs are locally developed assessments).





Teachers

- T-TESS average of 3.7
- T-TESS Dimension 2 & 3 average of 3.7
- Student growth performance minimum of 50%
- Above district average teacher impact (SAGE score of 50)
- Teacher was employed and compensated (or will be by the end of the school year) for a creditable year of service in a teaching role (087 role ID)
 - 50% of more of the day for a minimum of 180 days
 - 100% of the day for a minimum of 90 days, or the equivalent of one semester

Students

- Minimum of 10 students with appropriate pre-test [1]
- Enrolled during Fall and Winter snapshots [2]
- Minimum of 70% attendance
