


Bond 2020 Projects by Phase

Bridging the Gap

Challenge

Construction costs were projected to be \$402.3 million over budget due to inflation, supply chain challenges, construction labor demand, changes in educational specifications and design guidelines.



Solution

- Eliminate **LEED and BIM requirements**.
- Change procurement method for football, soccer, tennis scope.
- Refurbish and improve high softball and baseball fields with natural grass.
- Accept value-engineering options to bring projects closer to budget.
- Leverage master plan and phasing options.
- Transfer project inflation contingency to construction budget.



Important Note About Project Scope

We do not just lop off scope!

It's the easiest route BUT not the best approach for our students, educators, or community.





Strategic Project Review Process

- Apply a strategic review process to every project, digging deep to see how we can find ways to save across the entire project, versus just removing an entire scope.
- We may need to push a scope to a future bond but only if we've exhausted our options.

SAISD Rightsizing

- Study of school building capacity for the purpose of supporting thriving schools, classrooms, students, teachers, and school leaders.
- Involved closing school buildings, colocating schools to the same campus, or consolidating multiple schools into one school.
- 15 schools were rightsized at end of 2023-24 school year.





Leveraging Bond 2020

7 major renovation projects canceled under Rightsizing

Strategically leveraged major renovations planned for other campuses:

Foster ES



Students will join students at Schenck
ES after that school is renovated

Carroll ECE and Gates ES



Students will move to M.L. King Academy once that school is renovated to become a hub

Other renovation projects also in support of Rightsizing

- 1. Forbes ES to receive Steele ES students
- 2. Maverick ES to receive Baskin ES students
- 3. **Lowell MS** to receive Kelly ES students
- 4. Washington ES to serve as Pre-K-5



Future Rightsizing Recommendations

- After-Action Report on January HVAC Challenges accepted by board in May.
- Among findings are that "The Board direct the superintendent to conduct a comprehensive study of excess facility capacity, and that the study should include recommendations for rightsizing schools, programs and central office."
- Study to be completed by November 2025.

Security & Technology Update



 Underway this summer are wireless upgrades to Edison High School; Davis and Tafolla middle schools; Advanced Learning Academy-Euclid; and Collins Garden, Madison and Neal elementary schools



- Improvements include wi-fi access in school courtyards, gyms, music buildings, JROTC, cafeterias, and auditoriums
- By the start of the school year, 100% of classrooms, teachers, admins, and paraprofessionals will have received new SMART boards and computers.
- This summer, we expect to begin security upgrades, including cameras, intrusion alarms, and door badge reader systems, at 70+ schools
