SAMSD SAN ANTONIO Overview

Schools that effectively engage families find that their students earn higher grades, score higher on tests, develop better social skills, and are more likely to graduate. By asking parents and guardians to provide feedback through surveys, schools and districts can gather actionable data and better understand how to build effective partnerships with families. The Family-School Relationships Survey provides schools and districts with a clear picture of family attitudes about an array of topicsincluding family engagement, barriers to engagement, school climate, and family efficacy. SAISD gathered families' input from February 19 through April 5.

Note: While the domain names remain the same as previous years, the questions and answer scales were changed for the 2023-24 school year. As a result, scores from the 2023-24 school year should not be directly compared to results from previous years.
