## Family-School Relationships Survey Overview

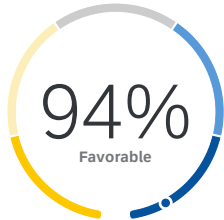

The Family-School Relationships Survey provides schools and districts with a clear picture of family attitudes about an array of topics—including family engagement, barriers to engagement, school climate, and family efficacy. SAISD gathered families' input from February 19 through April 5.

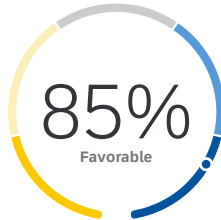

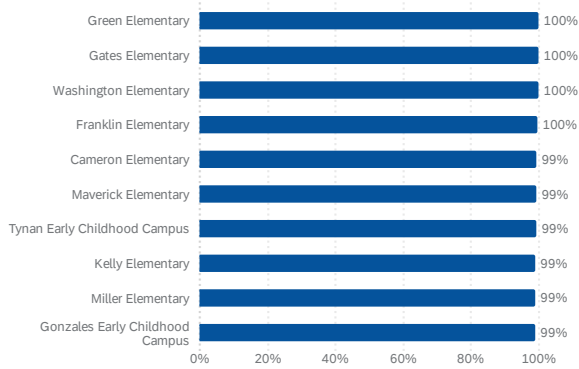

The charts below show the 10 highest scoring schools and the 10 lowest scoring schools based on the percent of favorable responses for each of the six domains.

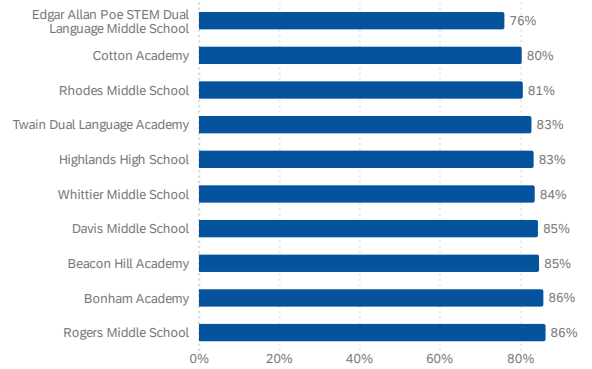

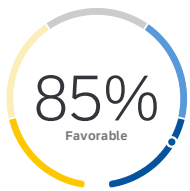
#### Family Engagement and Input % Favorable - (Top 10 Schools)



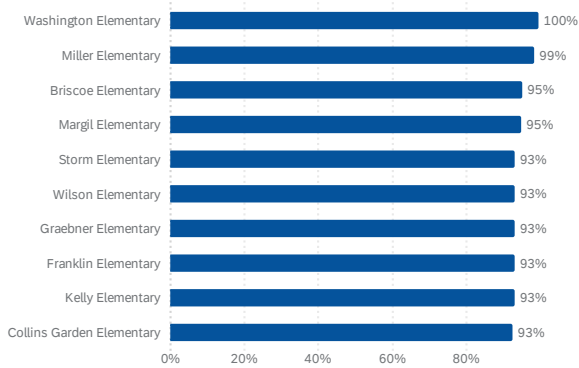

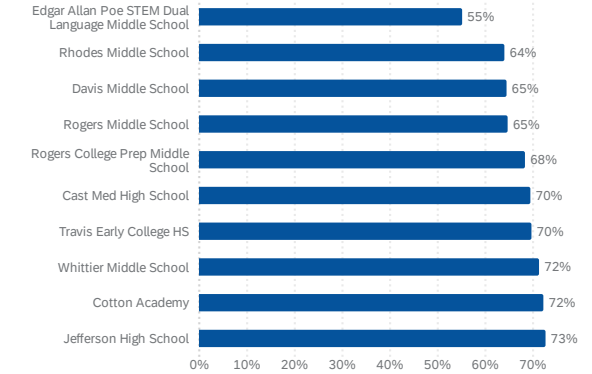

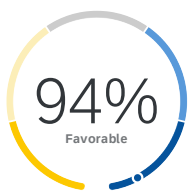

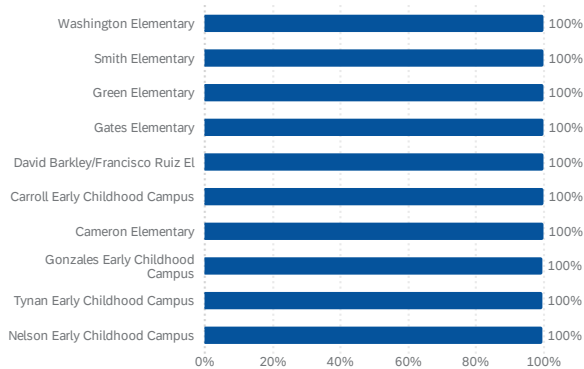

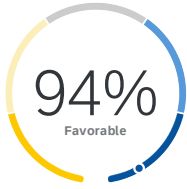

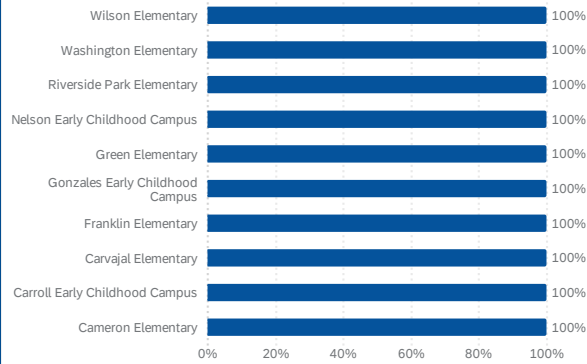

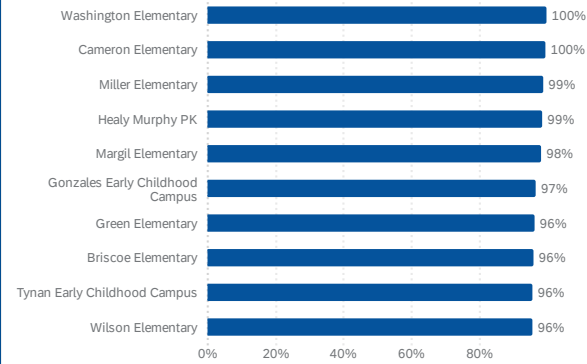

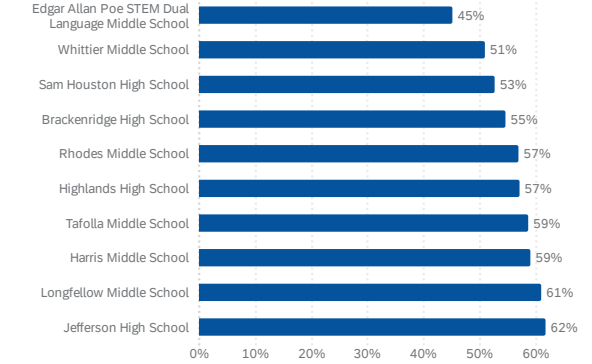

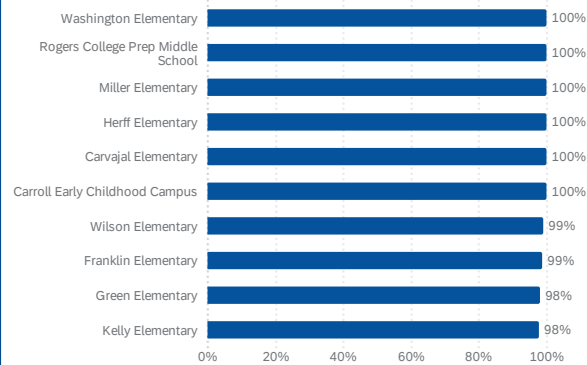

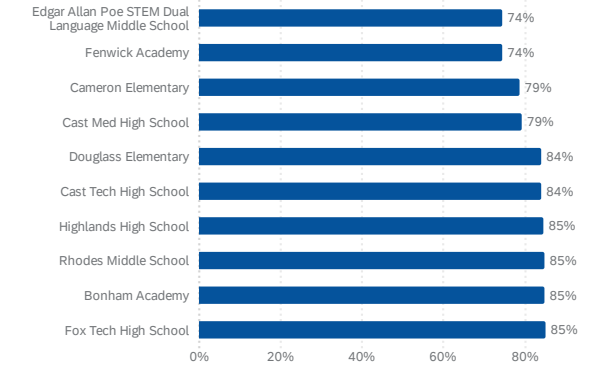

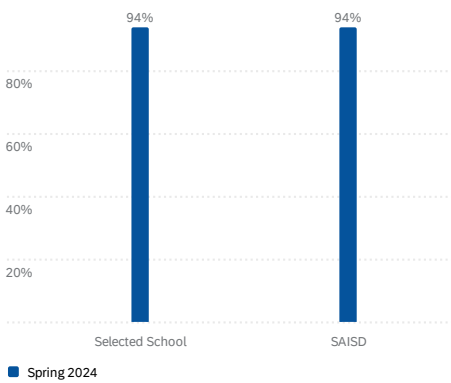

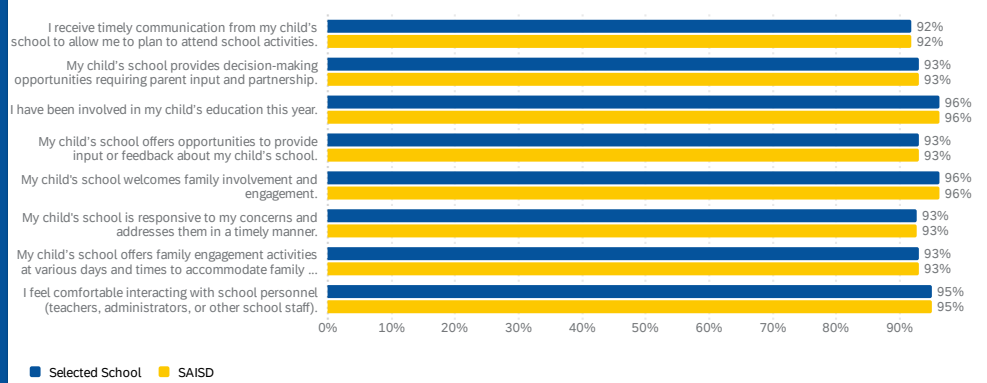

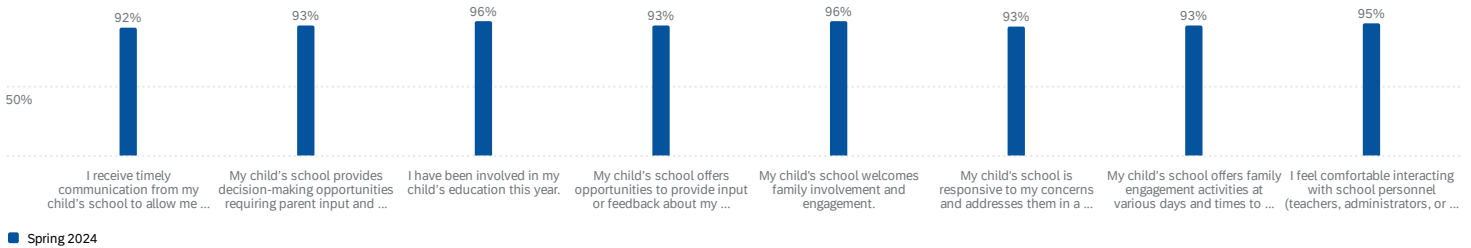

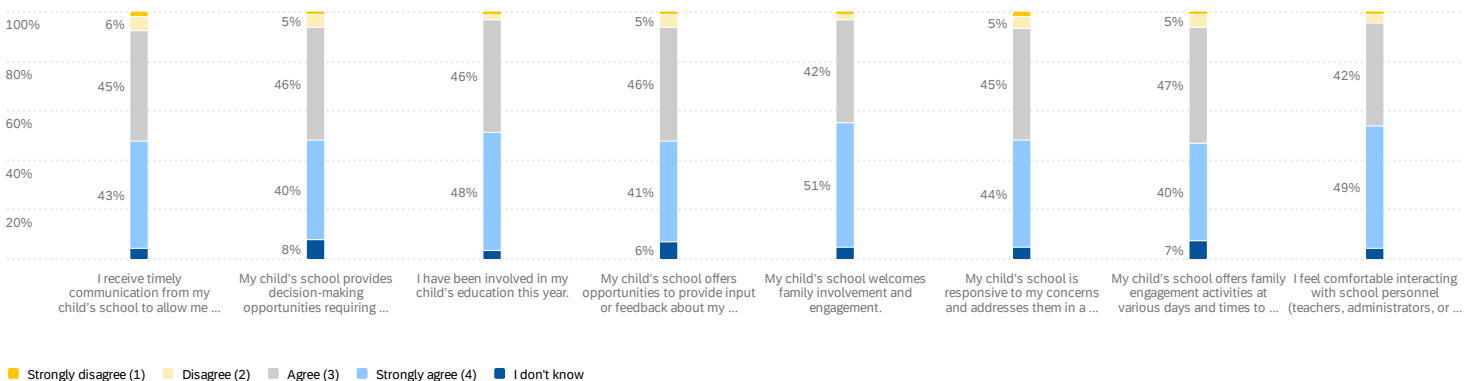
### Percent Favorable by Question (Selected Year)

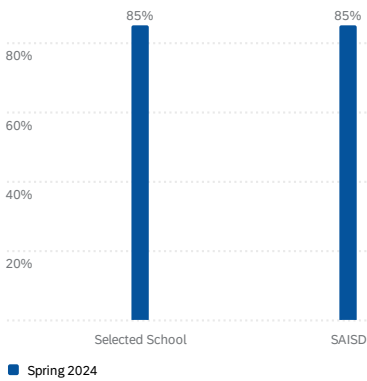

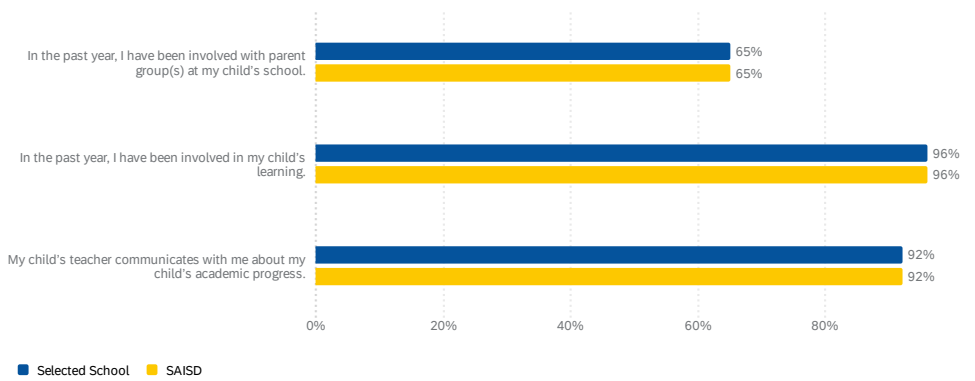

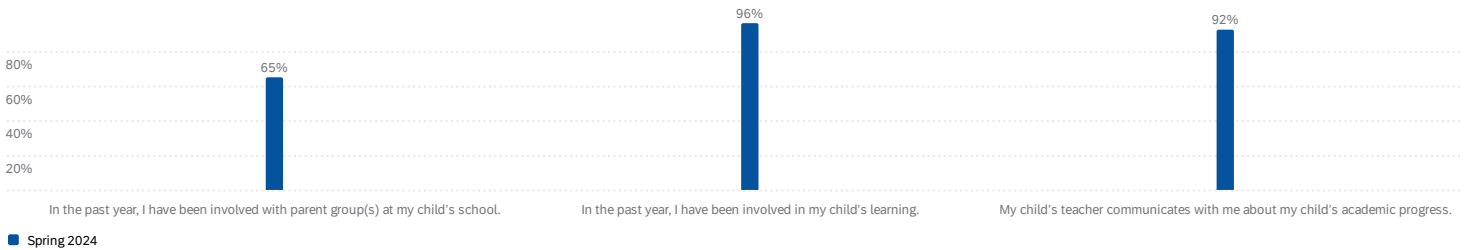

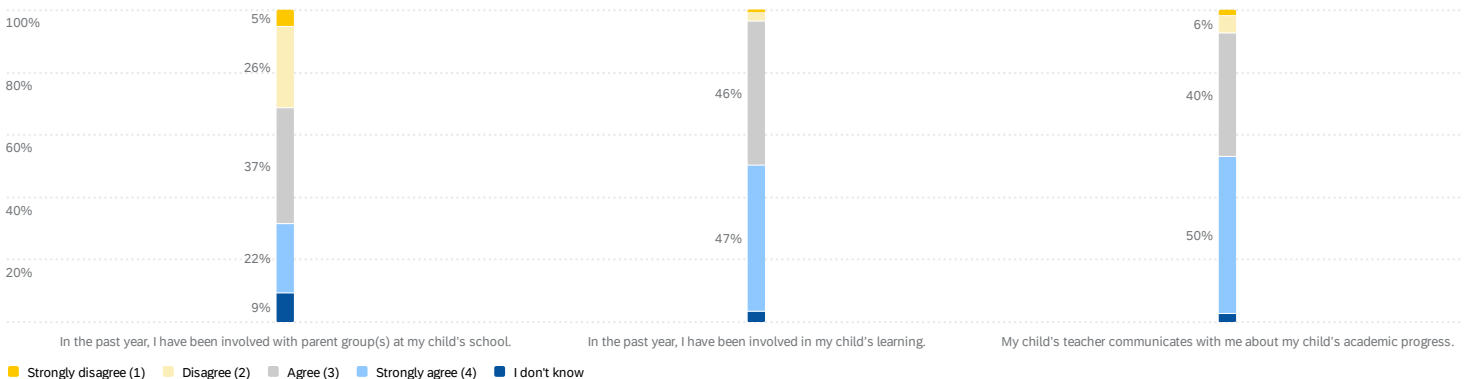
### Percent Favorable by Question (Selected Year)

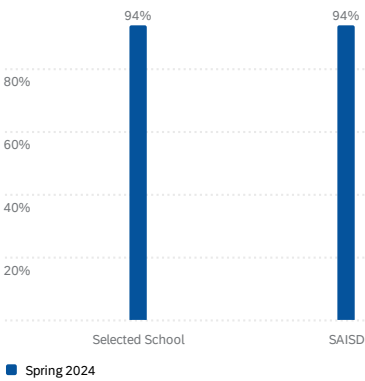

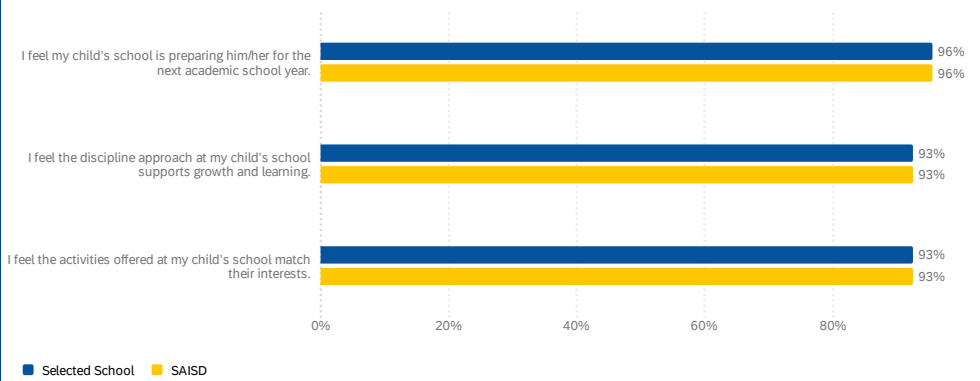
Families' perceptions of how a school matches their child's developmental needs.

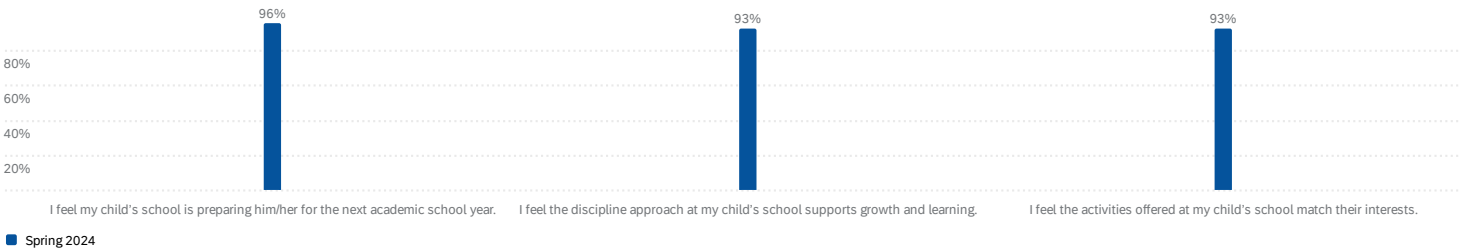

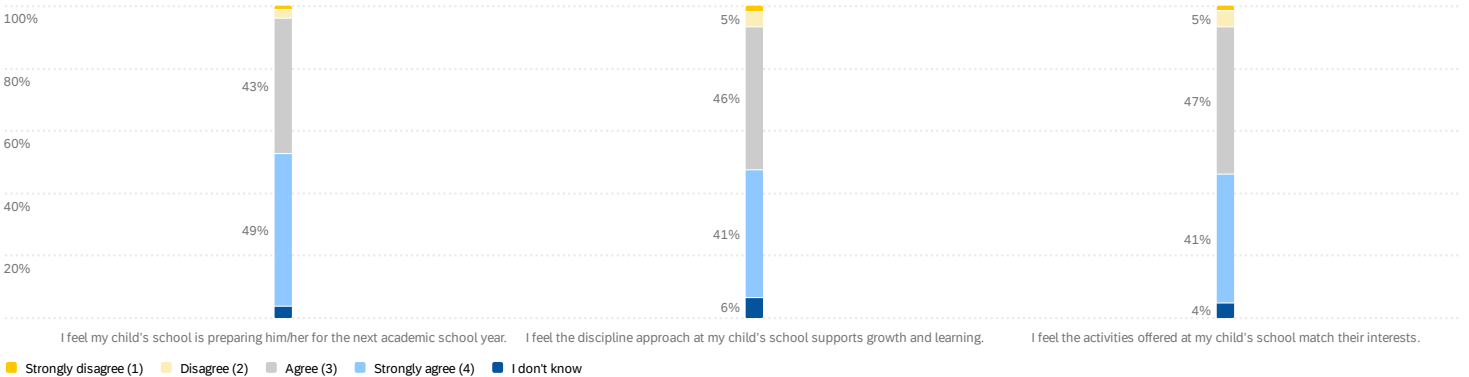
### Percent Favorable by Question (Selected Year)

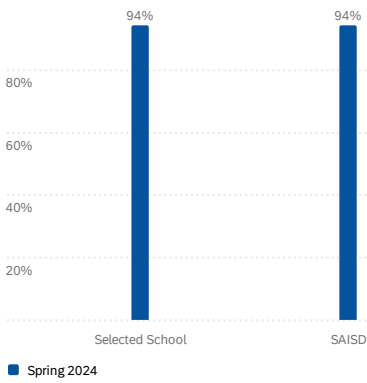

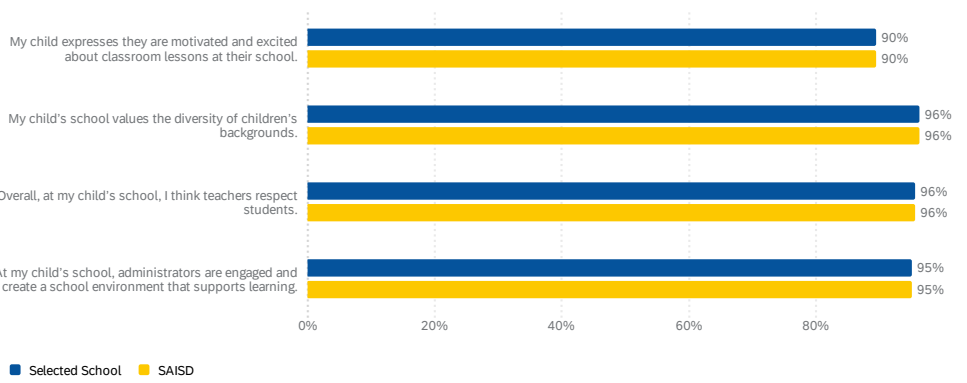

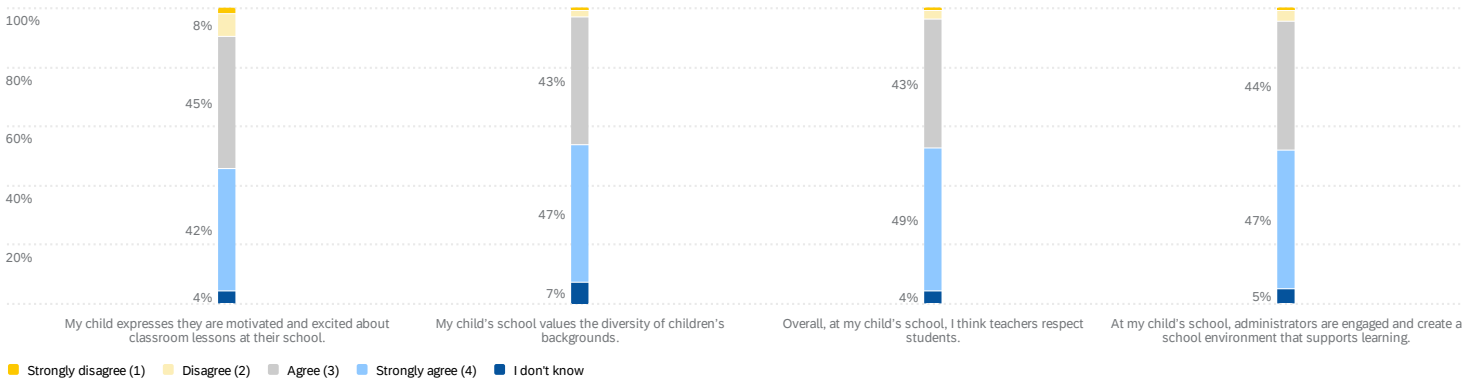
### Percent Favorable by Question (Selected Year)

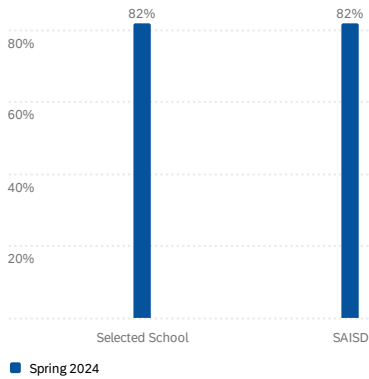

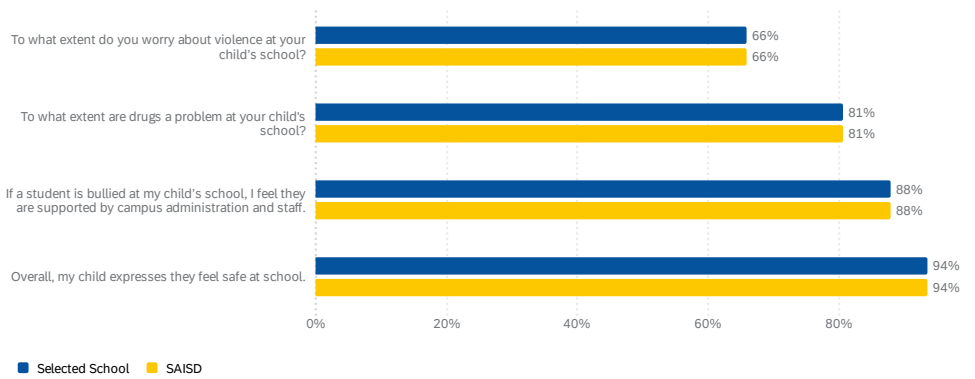

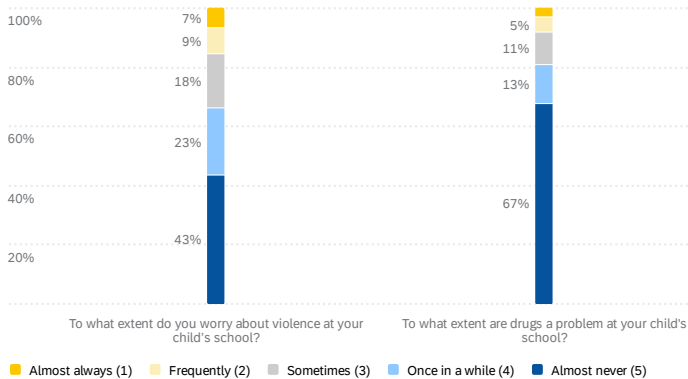

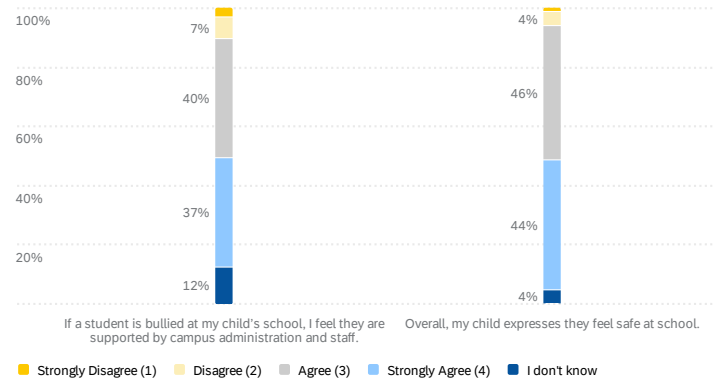
### Percent Favorable by Question - Yearly

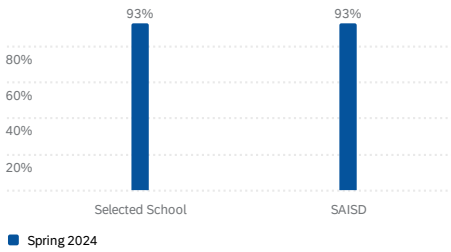

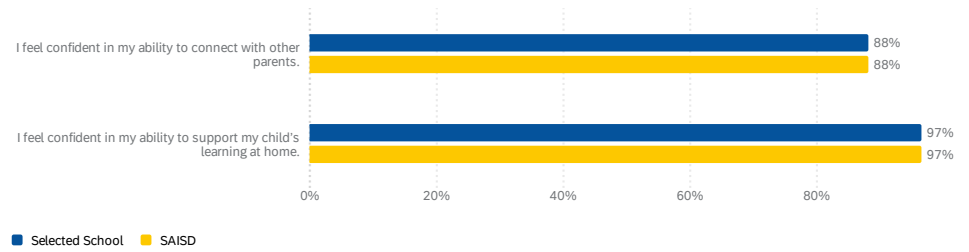
How confident families are with regard to key parenting skills.
