Routine Door Checks:



District staff routinely check exterior doors and hardware to ensure they are working and securing properly.

Silent Panic Alarms:



All campuses are equipped with a silent panic alarm in case of a threat in which an officer will respond in any circumstance when it is activated.

Video Surveillance



24/7 monitoring of live cameras throughout the district

SAISD Police Officers:



Officers are stationed at traditional middle and high schools. Coverage to elementary schools are supported by our special operations units. Patrol division operates 24 hrs. a day, 7 days a week.

P3 Tip Hotline:



Anonymous tip line to report anything by text, call, or internet 24/7

Mental Health:



All officers have received district and state mandated mental health training; the mental health unit and therapy dogs respond directly to persons in crisis at schools.

Numbering of Exterior Doors:

All exterior doors on all buildings will be numbered for quick reference for emergency situations.













Coordination With Other Law **Enforcement Agencies:**



SAISD Police are able to communicate with other agencies directly; all campus maps are shared with SAFD and SW Texas Fusion Center.

Training



All staff, including substitutes, are trained in emergency response. Students and staff participate in emergency drills.
